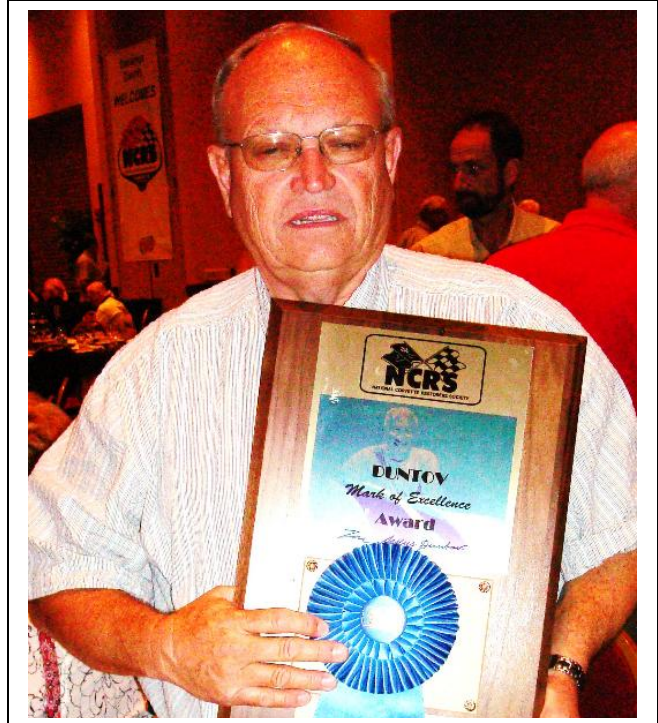

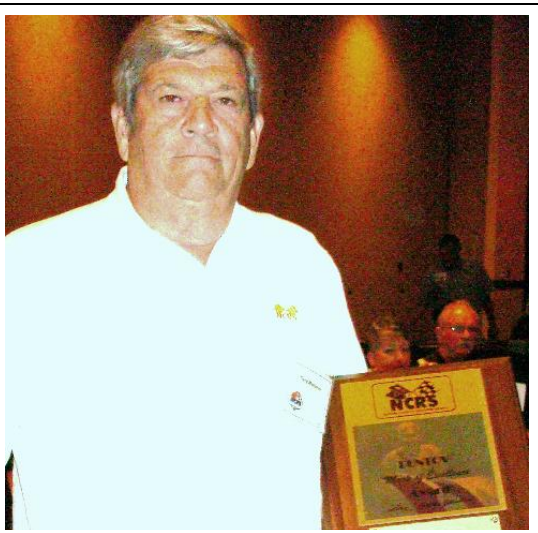
Steve then thanked Carl and Kathy for hosting and having a great meal prepared. The meeting was then dismissed.
