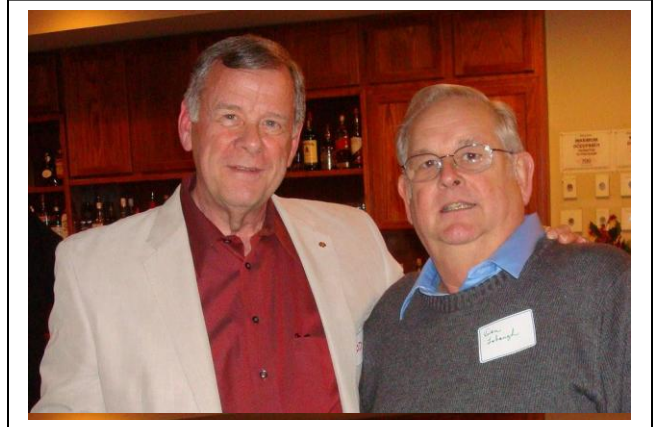
QCNCRS Christmas Party

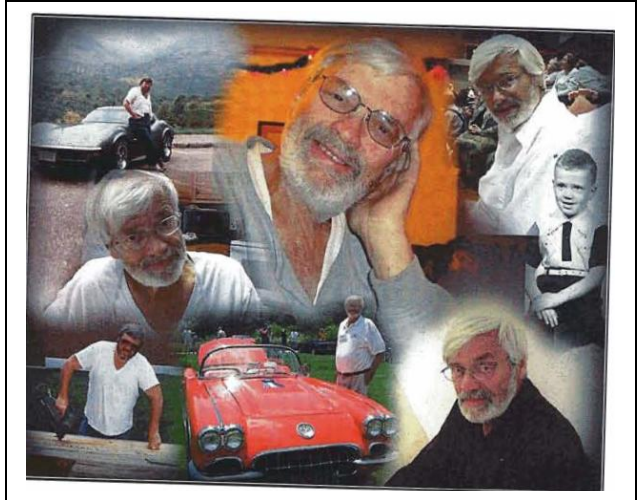
