Chairman's Message

Heart of Ohio Chapter-NCRS members in the past I have written about Corvette events past, present and future. However this time, with a heavy heart, I wish to pay tribute to Stew Van Kirk, a short term Heart of Ohio Chapter Secretary/Board Member, Friend and fellow car enthusiast.

As I have communicated to you in past email messages, Stew was fighting this past summer with stage four colon cancer. During Stew's bout with cancer, in late September, Stew underwent cardio vascular bypass surgery on top of having to wage war with his cancer spreading disease. I visited Stew at the Ohio State University hospital a few times and, as I recall, Stew did little talking on how he felt. Stew never volunteered his feelings of pain or suffering but, like a Special Forces soldier, kept his emotions hidden from friends and family. Well, Stew Van Kirk passed away this past Friday, October 27th in the late evening hours.

Stew, from what I have come to know, was a very quiet, humble, self-made man. I have found out much of this quiet man, aside from his passion for cars. Stew was an Army man in the 101st Air Borne unit then joined the Special Forces graduating from Kentucky Military Institute. Stew had spent 27 plus years in the Army, achieving rank of Lieutenant Colonel. After retiring from the Army, Stew attended Ohio Dominican College obtaining a degree as a CPA. Stew has a son; Stewart M. Jr. Stew Jr. who is married to Elena with son Jason and lives in Greece where he is employed as a programmer. I find it hard to correct programs in English in the US; I can't imagine the headaches with a language barrier to boot and having to deal in Greek. Stew had been caring for his mother at home and come to find out Stew has an older brother Tom that comes over to care for mom as well.

Stew was a collector of many items, HO trains, military manuals, Model "A" Ford, Ford parts and special equipment. Stew has a few model "A" bodies and parts in his four-stall over-loaded garage. Stew had collected a single 55 "T" bird with a recent October purchase of "T" bird parts to satisfy the bird craving. Stew's latest passion turns out to be Corvettes. We will have to forgive Stew for thinking "Ford' but it was still a car passion. Stew's stable of Corvettes included a recent purchase of a low mileage ruby red 1993 C4, a bright yellow C3 Shark better know as "Sponge Bob" and a gray 290 horse, 57' project Corvette.

Stew has been married to Pam for a couple of years now. Pam and Stew met at a company they both worked at. Pam to me has always watched over Stew like a mom with a mom and child relationship. Pam, bless her soul, as of late played nurse to both Stew and Stew's mom. I find that Pam was the practical half of their relationship and Stew was more the silent stubborn half. I really met Pam at a Heart of Ohio Chapter tour of Trim Parts in Lebanon, Ohio. It was a most memorable meeting after our tour but, since that meeting we still laugh about the encounter.

In the months of July August and September a group of Heart of Ohio Chapter members had begun assisting Stew in achieving the goal of restoring Stew's 57' C1 Corvette. The 57' is in a project state but with most of the major costs completed. The body is in great shape, painted, the frame painted, the engine painted and nearly complete. What needs to be accomplished is the assembly and finding out the little parts that maybe missing.

I wish to thank Gary Brown, for his helpful words that gave Pam the knowledge and insight on what to do at this time of crises. Also, to all those

Members Rink, Zuniga, Singer, Eyl (Joe and Mary Carol) and Harlton were there to greet them and to get things set-up for Saturday's judging. Later that evening we all headed over to the Glass City Barbeque for dinner and libations.
