work on Stew's project. At the moment work has been suspended waiting for parts and supplies.

The Van Kirk Project members have completed derusting, metal prepping and painting a rebuilt, numbers matching 283 cu in engine block. The body of the 57' needed new seat support floor nuts and cages installed between the fiberglass layers in the floor area. Stew enlighten us by saying that this was his Waterloo. This piece of the project has held progress up for many years. The nut/cage new parts have been riveted in and glassed over completing this task. The cast iron Single four barrel Intake manifold was to be used for the project but need to much de-rusting to make it worth while. So, the better option was to clean the dual quad Aluminum intake manifold. The Aluminum intake manifold is nearly completed. The distributor has been cleaned metal prepped and painted. Most of the Chrome parts have been cataloged; pictures take and boxed up for transport. The transmission has been disassembled, cleaned and worn, broken parts identified. Dash gauges have been taken apart and in clean up process.

Stew mentioned that he will be taking a trip to Pennsylvania soon to deliver his chrome parts to one of the well know plating companies in PA. The Carter carburetors are scheduled to be sent out soon

for a full restoration. Parts for the transmission will need to find a vendor to obtain first and main gears for replacements. The flywheel was sent out to a local machine shop and waiting its return. Paint for small dash gauge parts and paint for exhaust manifold are on order. So all in all there has been quite of bit of work compiled on the Van Kirk project to date.

For the past two Saturdays and the past Sunday our members have voluntarily spend time with Stew and myself in Stew's garage working diligently on the quest to see this icon visit the streets once more. Please join me in thanking the following individuals for assisting Stew in the ultimate restorer's quest in completion of his project. First and foremost, thank you Stew Van Kirk for giving us the opportunity to work on a fine specimen of a gone by era, the early Corvette. If I missed any one I apologize. I will be sure to include you next message.
