With the number of cars being restored these days, it's crucial to find good parts. VanDerBrink Auctions is going to help Corvette restorers with a major auction of parts to take place March 24, 2007, at 1301 Monmouth Street in Cincinnatti, Ohio.

Seems that Tom James has been restoring Corvettes for 32 years and began a Corvette salvage yard many years ago. Many parts, most of them NOS, will be up for auction including a 1963 coupe rear window roof section and other 1963 NOS parts. There also will be many NOS 1967 Corvette trim pieces, which are just about impossible to find.

Also being sold are NOS trim rings with the correct clips on the inside, 1978 Pace Car decals, NOS chrome exhaust extensions for mid-year cars, used doors, dashes, transmissions, air cleaners, radiators and just about every other Corvette part you could need or want from the 1950s through the 1980s.
