Tech Article-Dino Lanno

Put a set of rebound straps on my 1961 frame.....decided best way to install the rear axle in a bare frame was in this order

1. Rebound straps
2. Insert bare axle housing mount radius rods
3. Mount springs
4. Front shackle then rear shackle to frame
5. Insert posi
6. Brake back plates and axles
- 7 shocks, stabilizer

I used a borrowed corvette central rivet tool, worked well. Short loops inside, rivets inserted out to inside like my factory ones. 1 hour job





Tech Article - INSTALLING C- 1 FIREWALL INSULATION FASTENERS-Joe Eyl

The easy way to get these fasteners in that I have found is the use of these tools that I have made. It is hard to get these fasteners in the hole and to get the end to go through enough for the plug tip to expand so it stays in place.

I made this with little time and material that were ready available.

I put the piece of tubing over the end of the fastener to hold the front part flat. This gives you an easy way to align the insulation and the hole in the firewall with the point of the tubing. I insert the rod in the other end and push with that to get the tubing and the fastener through the hole. I also use liquid soap on the fastener to get the tubing on and also aid it going through the hole. The tubing is .500 outside with the point made from wood plug. The push rod .250 dia I used a tapered drift to open the end of the tubing so it fit over the fastener.
