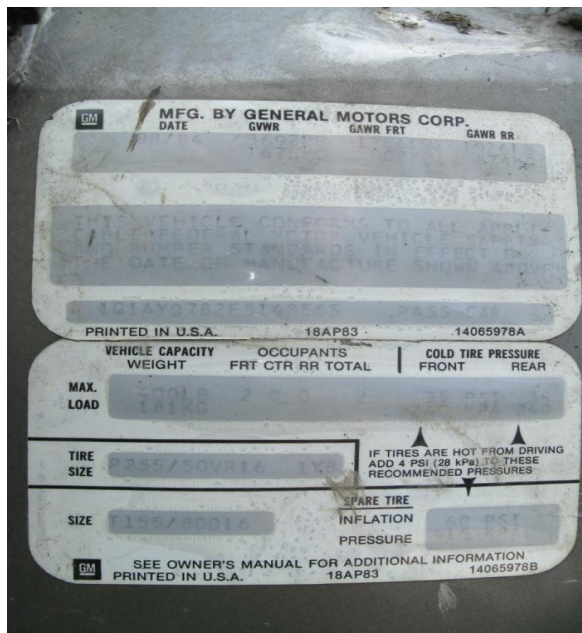


Meet new member-Terry Keating from Westerville, OH. Terry has been an NCRS member since 1970 (#669)!

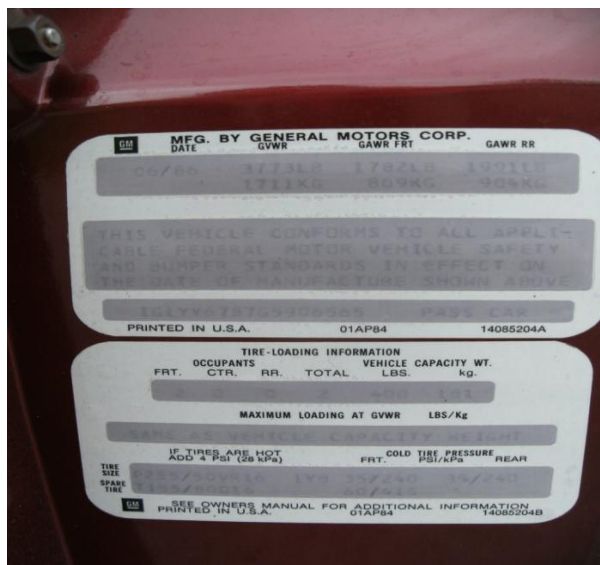
Terry owns a 1960 Honduras Maroon corvette with 225k miles. Welcome Terry!

Tech Article – C4 Tire Labels –Mike Treece.

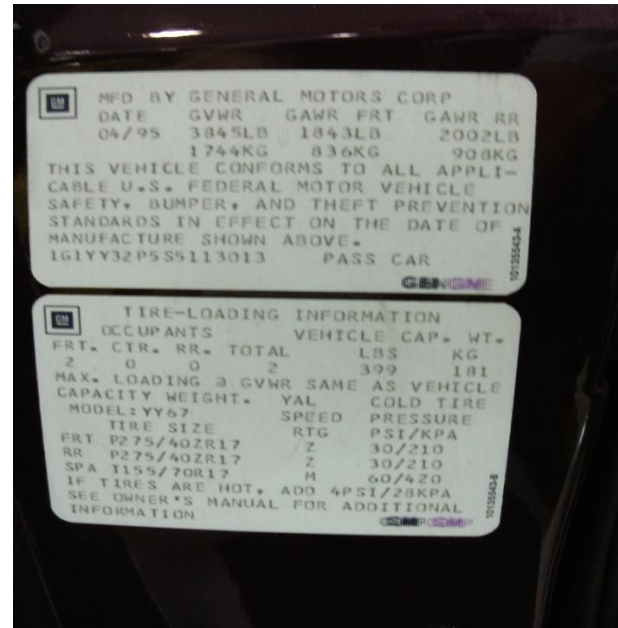
Mike Treece has compiled some detailed information on the different type of tire labels used by GM on C4's.



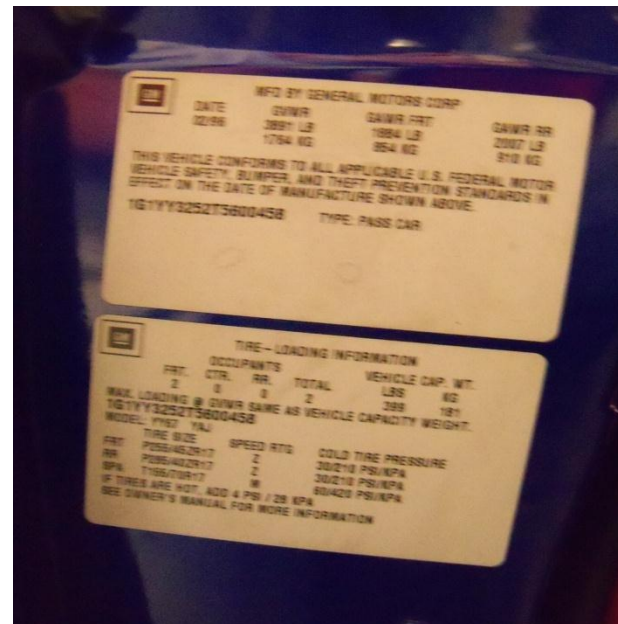
1984 Tire Label
