I recently attended the C5/C6 bash at the National Corvette Museum as they released pricing and specifics of the 2013 Corvette and the anticipated 427 Convertible. On hand was VIN #5 of the 427 Corvette decked out with the new 'Night Race Blue', a blue top and Blue/Black interior. The color has a lot of metal flake and is a chameleon. The color looks to be of a mid-year Laguna/Daytona Blue in the shade, a late C4 blue/purple in the sun, and black at dusk. Many of the Anniversary Package Vettes (RPO Z25) were on hand for an up close and personal tour. The wow factor was captured in the Anniversary 427 with the blue stripe impregnated into the canvas top. According to Chief Engineer, Tadge Juechter, this was no easy feat. This was just perfected, as production is delayed, as the vendor finalizes the top. This is the last year for the C6. In the final year, Corvette will have three serial #1's and three last C6's to be produced. The three unique VIN numbers are the 427, the ZR-1, and everything else (Z06, Coupe, GS Coupe, Convertible and GS Convertible). VIN #1 ZR1 and Z-06 were on display in the 60th anniversary package. VIN #1 427 convertible was sold at Barrett Jackson's in Scottsdale earlier this year for a 600k hammer price.

GM starts official 2013 model year production on April 30, 2012, but already they are accepting orders with 60 great examples already complete. The 2013 will run through February 1, 2012 as they start to retool the plant for the C7 (2014). Last orders are rumored to be accepted Oct 15th, with plant tours stopping Sept 10th, making a plant tour not an option as part of Museum Delivery (RPO RC8).

The C7 has many unconfirmed rumors, but GM is excited that when the C7 is unveiled it will have no impact on the current model. This is a first in Corvette history. One would assume then the C7 would be unveiled after Oct 15th 2012 for the 2014 model year. Market speculation is much like the C5 and C6 in the beginning; only a coupe will be available. The convertible may be made available mid production run for 2014. GM will also follow suit with the C6 of adding additional models as the generation matures, so not sure when Z-06 and Grand Sports will be available. The ZR1 will go into hibernation as GM adopts CAFÉ (Corporate Average Fuel

Economy). This leads to wide speculation for the end of LS-3, LS-7 and LS-9's as we know it. This sounds much like history is repeating itself, and it looks to be the year 1975.

As a special treat we discovered something very amazing. In 2010 our chapter took a road tour to the museum, and the museum captured a photo published in their magazine. The photo was so impressive it has a home within the conference room. The cars in the photo are Dale Felty's 1971, Ross Backe's 2002, Jerry Croy's 2007, Bob Hiney's 1992, Nick Kammer's 2003 and Mike Mill's 1966. This photo represents the C3, as the mural has every generation along with photos of each Chief Engineer with their corresponding generation. It is great to see the strength and longevity relationship between the Miami Valley Chapter NCRS and the Corvette Museum.
