NCC Meeting Minutes: **February 12, 2019**

Chairman Sharyl Ingham called the meeting to order and welcomed everyone to the January meeting at the St. Peter's Episcopal Church in Oakland at 7:00 pm. As usual, she asked the attendees to introduce themselves; stating their name, the city where they live, and the year(s) of the Corvette(s) owned. Most replied responsibly that they did one of two things: returned the cart to the designated area or placed the wheels over the curb so that it will not roll and damage any cars.

The minutes of the December meeting were approved by the NCC Board as submitted by Sharyl in Sandy's absence.

New Business:

Meals on Wheels: Sharyl handed out the letters and checks for the four counties that the Chapter donates to: Alameda, Contra Costa, Solano and Yolo. Rick Gower, Marci Albers, Glorie McNay, and Sharyl are NCC's liaisons. Sharyl went on to thank them for representing the Chapter.

Spring Meet in Suisun City April 26th-27th:

Three cars have registered so far and two more mid-year cars are expected. Mike made a plea for more judges!

Road Tour:

Wayne Yurtin said that he and Ken Albers are planning a tour to Wente Winery in Livermore on June 29th or 30th. Stay tuned, more to come.

Calendar Review:

Sharyl asked the members if NCC needed an activity in November. There was a slight discussion but will be continued at next meeting.

Lake Tahoe Regional: September 19th – 21st:

Sharyl mentioned that the spreadsheet of tasks/responsibilities is ready to forward to the membership asking for volunteers. She kindly mentioned that the upside to this is that there are only 8 positions to fill. She felt that we are making good progress. She is very appreciative and grateful for all the support!

Chapter Bylaws: NCC's Bylaws were last updated in 2004. Mike responded to Sharyl's draft revision saying that NCC's Bylaws should be consistent with NCRS Bylaws. Once the NCC officers review and adopt (hopefully at the March meeting) then it will be published and on the website.

Presentation to Allen Tremain: We saved the best for last. Mike recognized Allen for his continued contributions noting him being a National Team Leader but mostly of his years of service on the NCC Board by presenting him with an honorary NCC membership.

Thank you to Sharyl for drawing name tags in Glorie's absence.

Show and Tell:

Gary Beaupre showed a book: Mike Dixon "Factory of Dreams: St. Louis Corvette Plant." It has nice original factory pictures.

Sandy showed old car magazines that featured a mid-engine Corvette and other interesting prototypes.

John Tidwell compared an original "'58 to '60 Judging Manual" that was issued in 2000 to the new revised manual to be issued this year. The original is a skeleton of the current version.

Wayne Yurtin discussed a find in the Vette Vues Fact Book '63 to '67. Surprisingly it gives his VIN number as the time when the '63 high horsepower oil pressure gauges changed from 60 psi to 80 psi. John Tidwell described how authors extrapolate to determine such information.

Mark Pellowski said that his brother-in-law has acquired some parts from a '66 car that had been in storage for a long time. Mark has bought some of the parts including a complete '66 dash that he showed. Mark also discussed getting the correct frame stencil (2 lines versus 3 lines) from Quanta.

Rick Gower showed the Restorer Article Index from 2000 and a mount for '58 to '62 windshield washer bottle.

Casey Noel showed the Carter AFB carburetor and heat insulator from his '64. He had the carburetor rebuilt and said he not sure why he previously lost judging points for the heat insulator.

Mike Ingham showed the original passenger door handle from Sharyl's '69. The flap has a tendency to stick down so he bought a replacement handle. He also described the process of reinstalling the handle by first removing the door lock assembly. Look for all this in an upcoming tech article.

Adjournment:

Sharyl thanked everyone for bringing something for show and tell. Seriously this is absolutely a wonderful addition to our meetings!

Sharyl wished everyone an early Happy Valentine's Day and thanked everyone for coming to the meeting.

The meeting adjourned at 8:15 pm.





Dear Northern California Chapter,

The NCRS Foundation appreciates your Chapters donation in the amount of \$100. By contributing to the NCRS Foundation you are enabling us to expand the support of the NCRS Scholarship program. As we continue to grow the NCRS Foundation, we have been able to increase the number of scholarships being awarded as well as increasing the value of the scholarships.

I'm excited to report that the NCRS Foundation Board of Directors continue to recognize the generosity of the NCRS membership in support of the NCRS Foundation. At the 2018 March Board meeting, the board approved the following scholarships to be awarded for the 2018-2019 academic year: General Scholarships increased from 12-14 with 2 being utilized for automotive-related candidates meeting all requirements while increasing their value from \$1,500 to \$2,500; the Donald Majestic Memorial Scholarship will also increase from \$1,500 to \$2,500; the Gilbert Scrivner Memorial Scholarship awarded to the top overall candidate and the Marvin Burnett Memorial Scholarship for a candidate pursuing a degree in Education were also increased from \$2,500 to \$3,500. The Nebraska chapter will continue the annual \$1,000 Terrance Breher Memorial Scholarship which follows all the requirements of the scholarship program but will be granted to a qualified applicant sponsored by a current Nebraska Chapter member. If no eligible applicant, the scholarship will be awarded to another qualified candidate. In Summary, we will be awarding 18 Scholarships totaling \$45,500 which is an increase of \$20,000.

Since we began awarding scholarships in 2009, we awarded 5 Scholarships totaling \$6,500 while in 2017 we were able to award 16 scholarships totaling \$25,500. Since the first scholarships were awarded the Foundation has awarded a total of 94 scholarships totaling \$121,500.

In order to continue to grow the NCRS Foundation, I would ask that you consider making future contributions to the Foundation and build on your support level. Thank you again for your generosity. Enclosed you will find a NCRS Foundation Invoice documenting for your records your donation.
