The example that will be working on is a 1991 4L60 (a.k.a. a 700-R4). This transmission is very similar to anything found in 1982-2005 Corvettes. Differences between years and improvements through the years will be discussed.

I will also trace the entire spectrum of GM transmissions from 1939 to present, and will briefly mention 2006-2015 transmissions as well.

Several displays of transmission sub-units will also be displayed, such as valve bodies, front pumps, governors, input drum assemblies, 3-4 clutch assemblies, bands, etc.
